Seminar Overview

Inspired by the divine warrior image in the book of Isaiah and by Roman soldiers that pervaded all the Roman empire in the first century, the Apostle Paul metaphorically uses the main pieces of Roman armor to teach spiritual truths for overcoming the devil's schemes and forces.
