SHARING GOD'S Passion



A seminar equipping believers to share God's passion for the lost, prayer, worship, fruitfulness, and whole-hearted devotion.



Sessions

Overview

The Bible reveals five things that God is seeking. In the same way that the objects we search for reveal what we value, the objects God searches for reveal what He values, what He is passionate about.

As the Eternal Creator of all things, God alone can determine what has true worth and is of the highest value. As His children being conformed to the image of Christ, we should come into alignment with His supremely wise perspective and share His ultimate values. In other words, we should share His passion.

Unlike humans, God is not passionate about temporal material objects that we might consider valuable. Rather, He is passionate about people. According to the Bible, there are five kinds of people that God highly values – lost people, praying people, worshipping people, fruitful people, and devoted people. He so values these people that His passion moves Him to search for them.

If we are going to share God's passion, we must also value what He values. When we truly share His values, we will then prioritize seeking lost people and becoming the kind of people who pray, worship, bear fruit, and live devout lives.

This seminar introduces each of God's five values and provides relevant keys for applying these values to our daily lives.

SESSION 1: *The Importance of Values*

What is valuable? How is value assessed? What in this life has eternal value? How do our values shape our lives (six ways)? Shouldn't we value and prioritize the things that God highly values?

SESSION 2: *Sharing God's Passion for the Lost: A Look at Zacchaeus*

Jesus came to earth on a search and rescue mission. Through the account of Zacchaeus, we discover God's loving heart for lost people and the extent to which He goes to find them and save them.

SESSION 3: *Making Evangelism Practical*

What does it mean to be saved ... saved from what? What roles do the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit play in reaching lost people? What role do we play? Learn the essentials of the Gospel along with practical tools and organic methods for cultivating friendships, planting Gospel seeds, and reaping a harvest for Christ.

SESSION 4: *Sharing God's Passion for Prayer: A Look at Ezekiel*

Through Ezekiel, we discover that God seeks for intercessors who will build up the moral walls of His people and stand in the breaches to entreat His mercy on those deserving His judgment. God chooses to work in partnership with praying people who align with His heart and invite Him to accomplish His purposes on earth.

SESSION 5: *Making Prayer Practical*

Why is prayer important to God? What provisions has He made for us to approach Him boldly in prayer? Utilizing the Lord's Prayer and other biblical prayers, learn practical insights for praying more effectively.

SESSION 6: *Sharing God's Passion for Worship: A Look at the Samaritan Woman*

Through Jesus' encounter with the woman at the well, we learn that God seeks worshippers who will worship Him in Spirit and in truth. Dispel common misconceptions about worship and learn the essentials of true Spirit empowered worship.

SESSION 7: *Making Worship Practical*

Gain unique insights from the different biblical terms for worship. Learn what it means to be a holy priesthood offering up to God spiritual sacrifices acceptable through Christ. Discover seven spiritual sacrifices identified in the New Testament?

SESSION 8: *Sharing God's Passion for Fruitfulness: A Look at the Unfruitful Fig Tree*

Just as fruit is important to any farmer, God looks for spiritual fruit in His people. When a tree doesn't produce fruit, it might be deemed dispensable. Why waste good ground on an unproductive tree?

SESSION 9: *Making Fruit-bearing Practical*

What does it mean to bear spiritual fruit? In addition to natural fruit, the Bible metaphorically uses the concept of fruit in eight different ways, many of these apply to the type of fruit God is looking for in our lives. How do we assess the fruit of our lives? What are biblical keys to bearing fruit and how do we practically apply them?

SESSION 10: *Sharing God's Passion for Devotion: A Look at King Asa*

God is searching for people who are totally devoted to Him, who trust Him, and who obey Him. What does it mean to be devoted to God?

SESSION 11: *Making Devotion Practical*

What does it mean for us to wholeheartedly love God, obey God, worship God, seek God, fear God, and serve God? How do we love Christ supremely? What does devotion to Christ look like in daily life?

Each session is 35 minutes for a total instructional time of 6.5 hours. Worship, breaks, and meals will increase the total length of the seminar.
